Things to work on this Summer:

- It is a great help if our students know how to do the following things at the start of the school year!
 - o They are able to recognize their name. We label everything by your child's name. So they need to be able to find their name amongst of others.
 - o Go to the bathroom independently.
 - o Use glue and scissors appropriately.
 - o Taking turns with other children.
 - o For your child to have the ability to get in and out of the car independently, including buckling. This is important if you are dropping off or picking up your child from school.
 - o Try to prepare your child for being separated from their caregivers.
